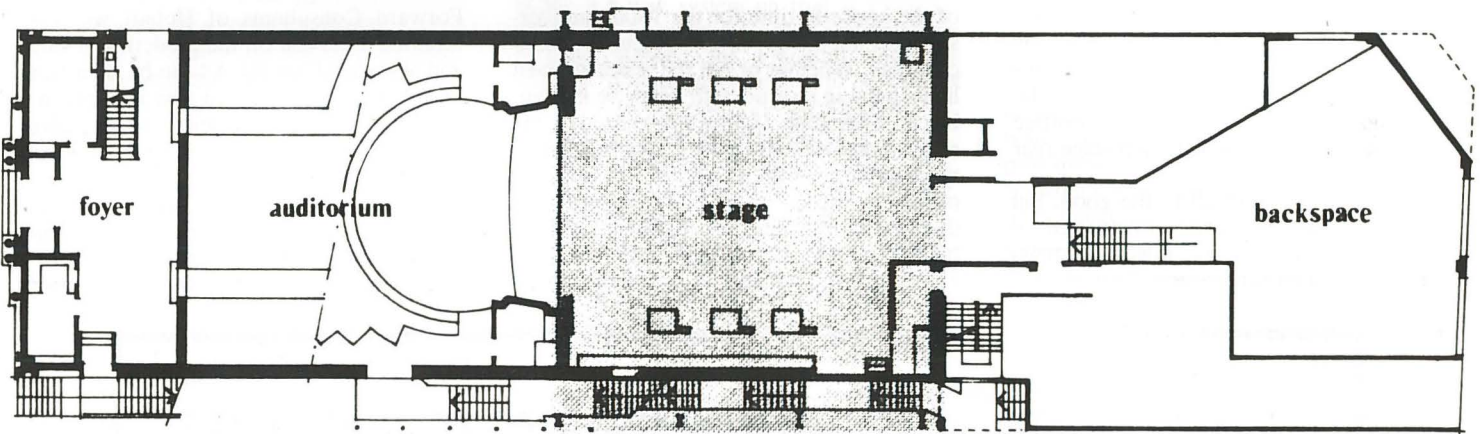


Theatre Royal, Hobart restored 1986 with a rebuilt and heightened stage house to accommodate a modern scenery flying system.

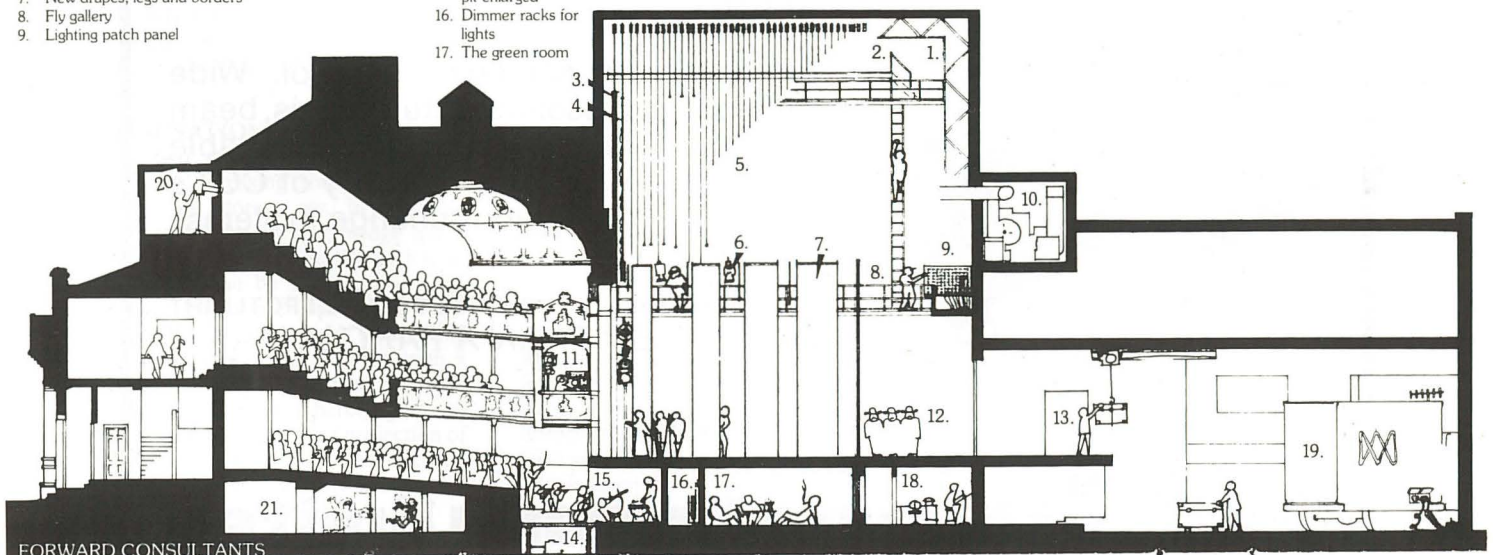
stage floor level plan
