Richard Pilbrow, age 48, founder and Chairman of the Theatre Projects Group, is one of the world's leading lighting designers, responsible for over 250 productions in London, New York, Paris and Moscow. He is an internationally

recognized theatre, film and television producer, with such productions to his credit as "Fiddler on the Roof", "A Little Night Music" (theatre), "Swallows and Amazons" (film) and "All You Need is Love — the story of popular music" (TV).

Richard Pilbrow's role as a Theatre Consultant is distinguished by his appointment to the National Theatre of Great Britain and by the creation of the world's leading consulting practice in this field. He was a founder of the Association of British Theatre Technicians, the Society of British Theatre Designers and the Society of Theatre Consultants. He was a member of the Drama Panel of the Arts Council, the Building Committee of the National Theatre and the Executive of the Society of West End Theatre. He is a Vice-President of the National Youth Theatre.
